EXALTATION OF THE HOLY CROSS



The feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross (*14 September*) celebrates two historical events: the discovery of the True Cross by Saint Helena, the mother of the Emperor Constantine, in 320 under the temple of Venus in Jerusalem, and the dedication in 335 of the basilica and shrine built on Calvary by Constantine, which mark the site of the Crucifixion. Solemn Vespers (Evening Prayer) will be offered on Thursday, 14 September at 6:00 p.m. at the Church of Our Saviour. The Choir of the Church of Our Saviour will sing and the liturgy will be attended by members of the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre of Jerusalem. All are warmly invited to attend.
